APPLICANT AUTHORIZES AUSTIN FLEET MAINTENANCE D/B/A FLEET MAINTENANCE OF TEXAS, INC. TO INVESTIGATE APPLICANT'S CREDIT REFERENCES AS GIVEN AND SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZES THE RELEASE OF INFORMATION AND/OR DATA BY SAID REFERENCES AND BY ANY CREDIT INFORMATION BUREAU HAVING ACCESS TO APPLICANT'S CREDIT RECORD TO AUSTIN FLEET MAINTENANCE D/B/A FLEET MAINTENANCE OF TEXAS, INC. OR IT'S AGENTS OR REPRESENTATIVES.

AUSTIN FLEET MAINTENANCE D/B/A FLEET MAINTENANCE OF TEXAS INC. located at 4800 East 7th Street, Austin, TX Travis County, Texas, hereinafter called SELLER, agrees to extend credit, subject to credit check and approval to applicant, hereinafter called BUYER. BUYER, by his signature hereto, agrees to enter into the open credit agreement and accept the foregoing terms and conditions. BUYER, in consideration of the extended by seller for goods, materials and services sold to the Buyer agrees to:

1. Be responsible for all credit extended by Seller in connection with this account;
2. Pay Seller, at the place designated on the periodic statement, all drafts and obligations evidencing the credit and all extensions thereof, and when applicable, all service charges in full by the 10th day of each month following the month in which Buyer receives a periodic statement from the Seller, said billed accounts and service charges to be considered past due thereafter;
3. Pay a finance charge of 1.50% per month (18% per annual percentage rate any unpaid, past-due amount; (Buyer agrees that payments are to be applied first to accrued, unpaid interest charges and then to past due principal amounts and finally to new purchases or charges;
4. To pay Seller, on any default or failure to pay as agreed, its collection cost and a reasonable late charge. Buyer agrees further that Seller may at it's option, declare any indebtedness under the account immediately due and payable on default or failure to pay;
5. To bind Buyer's heirs, representatives, successors and assigns to the terms of this agreement;
6. To pay a service charge of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) which will be billed to the account of the Buyer for every check, draft, or other payment given to Seller for payment of goods and services sold to Buyer which is returned to the Seller marked "Insufficient Funds", "Account Closed" or "Payment Stopped". Buyer agrees said charge is not a payment of interest but a reimbursement to Seller for administrative costs of handling the returned check or other instrument;
7. Should it become necessary to place this account in the hands of an attorney or collection agency, the Buyer will be responsible for payment of all Sellers fees and expenses, including Attorney fees, (where legal) at all levels of collection and/or suit. The laws of the State of Texas shall prevail and venue shall be in the county of the Sellers parent corporation, "Austin Fleet Maintenance, Incorporated" in Austin, Travis County, Texas. The Buyer waives jurisdiction and venue (where legal). Service of process or arbitration notice upon the Buyer or its registered agent will be by U.S. Mail and/or "tacking" at the Customer's last known address and will be accepted by the Buyer and presumed received when placed in the mail or "tacked".
8. To perform this agreement in Austin, Travis County, Texas.

Seller reserves the right to amend or modify the provisions of this agreement at any time by mailing written notice of such amendment or modifications provided by law.

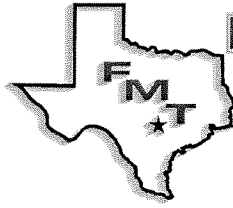

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Purpose of Form

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS, must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.

U.S. person. Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN to the person requesting it (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

1. Certify that the TIN you are giving is correct (or you are waiting for a number to be issued),
2. Certify that you are not subject to backup withholding, or
3. Claim exemption from backup withholding if you are a U.S. exempt payee.

In 3 above, if applicable, you are also certifying that as a U.S. person, your allocable share of any partnership income from a U.S. trade or business is not subject to the withholding tax on foreign partners' share of effectively connected income.

Note. If a requester gives you a form other than Form W-9 to request your TIN, you must use the requester's form if it is substantially similar to this Form W-9.

For federal tax purposes, you are considered a person if you are:

- An individual who is a citizen or resident of the United States,
- A partnership, corporation, company, or association created or organized in the United States or under the laws of the United States, or

Special rules for partnerships. Partnerships that conduct a trade or business in the United States are generally required to pay a withholding tax on any foreign partners' share of income from such business. Further, in certain cases where a Form W-9 has not been received, a partnership is required to presume that a partner is a foreign person, and pay the withholding tax. Therefore, if you are a U.S. person that is a partner in a partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States, provide Form W-9 to the partnership to establish your U.S. status and avoid withholding on your share of partnership income.

The person who gives Form W-9 to the partnership for purposes of establishing its U.S. status and avoiding withholding on its allocable share of net income from the partnership conducting a trade or business in the United States is in the following cases:

- The U.S. owner of a disregarded entity and not the entity,
